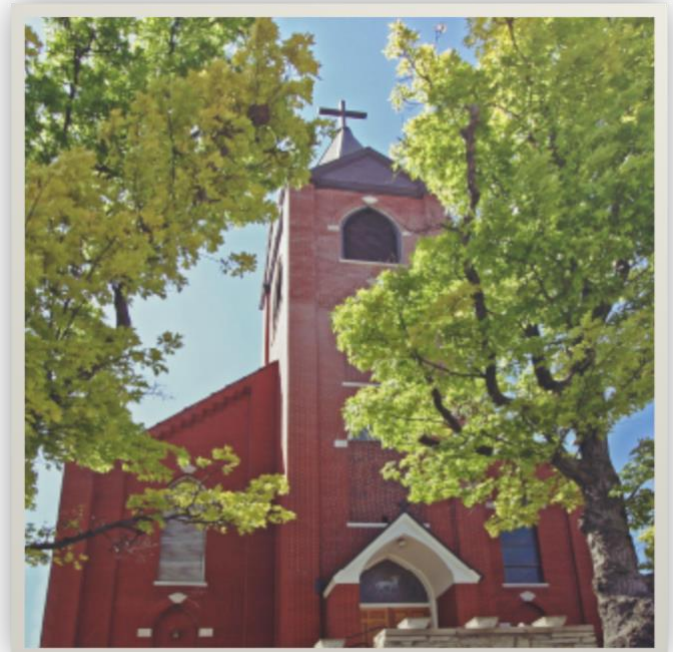

Our Chapter Celebrated its 50th Anniversary in 1988

An interesting page in our annual directory is the list of our chapter's former Deans. Long time members will recognize many of the names. Newer members will probably not associate many of the names with present day faces. Please note the founding Dean in 1938, Edna Scotten Billings. I found a photo of her, and some information about her that I thought you might find of interest.



In October, 1972, Edna Scotten Billings, pictured at the left, retired from the position of organist at Grace and Holy Trinity Cathedral after 50 years service. She was appointed organist at the Cathedral at age 21. She also retired in the same year from the Temple B'nai Jehuda Congregation, where she had been organist since 1951. She was the first Dean of the newly formed Kansas City Chapter of AGO.

Mrs. Billings was known for her graciousness and spirit. Many local organists benefitted from her encouragement and appreciated her positive attitude about her work. She was known for the vitality of her playing and the high standards she honored and promoted.
